John Fisher Park Local Ground Rules



All Diamonds (except T Ball): Base Coaches MUST wear protective head wear.

M1 & M2

Sliding Base Rule

In U7 & U8 Tee Ball only sliding bases (throw down bases) will be used.

This rule was written to protect the runner, not put him/her in jeopardy, and to provide safety. This rule will apply when:

1. The runner slides in, he/she is considered to be with the base. Remaining on the ground, if tagged, the runner is "SAFE". After sliding in, the runner stands up and makes no attempt to advance to the next base, if tagged, the runner is "SAFE". If the runner moves towards the next base and the fielder makes a tag before the runner can get back to where the base had been originally, the runner is "OUT". This is strictly the UMPIRE'S JUDGMENT.
2. A preceding runner moves the base off the spot more than the length of the base, following runners need only touch the original spot of the base.

It is recommended that all base locations be clearly marked before the game begins so that the runners have a visual point to touch and the umpires have a reference point.

M3

1. If the Ball is hit into the Canteen or the Footpath or a Lightpole on the full Ground Rule **HOMERUN**
2. If the ball rolls into the Canteen or on the Footpath or hits a Lightpole Ground **DOUBLE**

M4 & M5

1. If the Ball is hit onto the Footpath or Lightpole on the full Ground Rule **HOMERUN**
2. If the ball rolls onto the Footpath or hits a Lightpole Ground Rule **DOUBLE**
